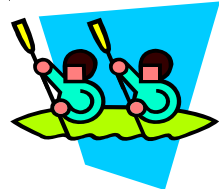


## **Mommy/Daddy and Me Kayaking**

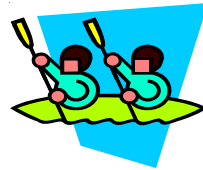
