We'll be using Bridges rooms, HES art room, gym, and cafeteria as well as the playground and HES ball field, the Town Beach (we register children for swim lessons run by the Harvard Park & Recreation Committee). We have an awesome staff who work within the school system during the year and really get to know the children. Our support staff are Bromfield students who have attended our programs. During week 3 and week 4, special field trips are in the works! We have a low student/staff ratio. We'll provide a tasty, cool afternoon snack. Students bring their own lunch Monday-Thursday. On Friday's we have a pizza party!

**Date of Note: Friday, July 15th** is the date for the Summer Adventure Theater Performance. Children will perform the play **"If I Ran The School"** for parents and friends. During the first two weeks of our program they create the sets, help with costumes, work "back-stage" and memorize their lines. It's amazing to see the end product in just 2 short weeks! No after program care is available on this day.

**Swimming lesson notes:** Lessons are 2 weeks in length. Summer Adventure will participate in swimming lessons during weeks 1, 2, 3 & 4. Summer Adventure staff bring the children to lessons (children with early lessons are dropped off at the pond by parents and check in with our staff). If you do not want your child to participate in swimming lessons, please circle "no lessons" on the registration.

Please complete the registration form and **return this form with a \$100 non-refundable deposit per session to the Community Education Office.** Enrollment is open to Harvard Residents and School Choice students. Students must be entering grades 1-6 in the Fall of 2011. *Space is limited and filled on a first-come first-served basis.*

Tuition balance is due by **June 1.** All forms, including current physical (within 13 months of program dates) are due in the Community Education office by **June 17th.**
